## I'm Letting Go

Music has always been an important part of my life. Yesterday I heard "Lift Me Up" by The Afters. When they sang in the chorus, "Your love catches me so I'm letting go," sweet memories of my dad came to mind. I pictured a little girl with pigtails standing on a high porch and a daddy standing on the ground looking up at his girl, saying, "Come on and jump ... I will catch you." No matter how many times this happened, I always knew that if I jumped, Daddy would catch me. I trusted him, and he always caught me. He never let me down. As I got older, I may not have been jumping off a porch into his arms, but I knew I could trust him if I needed help with anything life threw at me. When I became an adult, there were many times I would talk to Daddy about a problem or a situation. He would never tell me what to do but would always offer suggestions of how he would handle it. It was always my decision to make. Sometimes I made the right decision and things fell into place; sometimes I didn't, but even then, Daddy loved me and he would do everything he could to help me recover from the bad decision.

Our heavenly Father wants us to trust Him just like I trusted my dad when I would jump off the porch into his arms. God wants us to let go and allow His loving arms to catch us.
